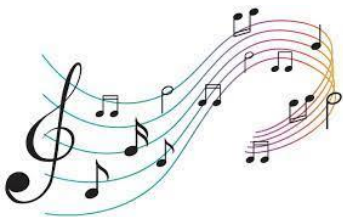
It was a great team effort but a huge Thank You must go to Tina for co-ordinating everything.

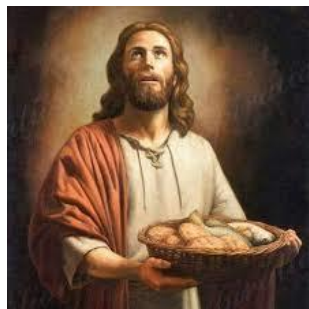
A harvest of apples, a harvest of corn;
